### **Driving Directions**

There are many ways to reach the State Capitol in Olympia, Washington.

**From I-5 Southbound:** Take "Exit 105 to State Capitol", keep left for Exit 105A, and continue .8 miles to the roundabout at Jefferson Avenue. Continue straight through the roundabout and under the tunnel to Capitol Blvd. Continue across Capitol Blvd to the Capitol Building on Sid Snyder Ave SW (14th Ave becomes Sid Snyder Ave).

**From I-5 Northbound:** From I-5 Northbound: Take Exit 105 and bear left for the State Capitol/City Center exit. Cross over Interstate 5 and continue .3mi to the roundabout at Jefferson Ave. Continue straight through the roundabout and under the tunnel to Capitol Blvd. Continue across Capitol Blvd to the Capitol Building on Sid Snyder Ave SW (14th Ave becomes Sid Snyder Ave).

### **Parking**

Please refer to the Campus Map for parking on the campus. Parking lots we are able to park in are highlighted on the map in pink. Price is \$1.50 per hour. You may also park in one of the DASH lots and take a shuttle to the Capitol Campus. Rates are \$1.50 per hour.



### **State Capitol Parking Information**

**(Please see attached map; designated parking areas are noted with a numbered box)**

1. **Professional Arts Building:** 11<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Washington St. The 48-stall lot includes a meter that accepts payment with either a debit or credit card at \$1.50/hour-\$12/day charge.
2. **Natural Resources P1 Parking Lot:** off Washington St. is metered parking
3. **South Diagonal Parking:** Located along the South Diagonal street on the Capitol Campus. There is a \$1.50/hour-\$12/day charge. Please note: No parking will be allowed on the North Diagonal on Film Day as another group has reserved that area for the day.
4. **Visitor Information Center Parking:** Located at 14<sup>th</sup> & Capitol Way. There is a \$1.50/hour-\$12/day charge.
5. **Employment Security Annex lot:** there are 14 visitor stalls.

### **Walking directions to OB2 from the Capitol Building**

1. At the bottom of the North Steps walk East (towards Capital Way)
2. Follow the sidewalk in the center of the lawns (towards the fountain)
3. Cross Capital Way and turn left (towards downtown)
4. Turn right at the 1<sup>st</sup> Pathway (green railing and between the 2 buildings)
5. Cross the street at the bottom of the walkway and go straight
6. Walk past the Highways-Licenses Building, turn right at sign: "Path to Office Building 2"
7. Enter door and follow short tunnel; turn left at sign marked: "Written/Oral Language testing"
8. Go through door toward "Written/Oral Language testing room"
- 9.. Follow long pathway, past the "Written Language Testing room" (SLO3)
10. Turn right at the Office Building 2 entrance (by mailbox)
11. The auditorium will be straight ahead
