

- FILM INDUSTRY COVID-19 COMPLIANCE -

EXPECTATIONS & SUGGESTIONS FROM THE WASHINGTON COVID-19 COMPLIANCE SUPERVISORS COLLECTIVE

Working amongst the COVID-19 pandemic has brought upon a large change to working safely. We have come together as a team to help support the production industry in getting back to work. Here are a few of our standards and recommendations when putting together any production.

All productions must comply with the state's set safety requirements as listed in the [Motion Picture Production COVID-19 Requirements](#) that was approved by the Governor's Office and the Washington State Department of Health. Production elements like location scouts, shot lists, blocking, call times, and even post production all have health and safety implications, therefore contacting a COVID-19 Compliance Supervisor (CCS) from the list at the bottom of the page at least 1 week prior to the first day of work is highly advised:

- Hiring CCS At Least 1 Week Prior To Shoot
- Possible Paid Prep - Project Dependent
- A CCS Personal Contract
- COVID-19 Testing - Project Dependent
- Questionnaire Creation & Distribution
- Custom Safety Plan Creation
- Kit Fee \$75 Standard
- PPE Supplies \$10+ Per Crew & Talent (Separate from Kit)
- Confidential Wrap Report & 2 Week Post Shoot Check-In for All Crew/Talent
- Feedback Following Project Appreciated

Depending on the project, it may be expected to hire various compliance team members ranging from manager to assistant, especially if your sets/locations are split or head count is over 20 people. Here is the list of potential compliance team arrangements and their average rates.

ALL RATES AND FEES ARE NEGOTIABLE DEPENDING THE SCALE OF YOUR PRODUCTION:

\$750/day	COVID-19 Compliance Manager (Used on Large Crews Over 20 People)
\$650/day	COVID-19 Compliance Supervisor (Standard For Crew Sizes 20 & Under)
\$400/day	COVID-19 Compliance Officer/Assistant (Support Day-Of Monitor)
\$100/hr	COVID-19 Compliance Officer/Assistant Partial Day - 3 Hour Minimum

The CCS is typically first on and last off set each day and will need to accomplish all their [mandated] duties within the hours set by production. Set-up and wrap for the CCS can take some additional time. Expect to add at least an hour to your schedule to accommodate compliance processes within your 10 or 12 hour days. This can affect the shoot time availability as well, so please keep in mind to make your shot lists and additional cleaning processes reasonable for the time allotted.

This position is essential and is enforced to help save lives. We are stewards of the protocols and ambassadors to the cause. It is hard to know everyone's situation and personal needs during this time. We are here to demonstrate and support all needs across the board for our industry to maintain and continue workflow. This position is new but necessary. Please respect the title and the persons willing to take up the responsibility and work load. As these requirements and processes are ever changing during these times, we are happily available for questions and assistance in your production needs.
