

About the Film Leadership Council (FLC)

Formed in 2018, the Film Leadership Council serves as an advisory board to Washington Filmworks (WF) Board of Directors and consists of 7 -18 film professionals from locations across the state that represent a wide array of motion picture production. The FLC works with WF's staff to develop proposals about how to maximize the impact of both the production incentive program and the resources of the state film office. They will also serve as advocates and ambassadors for WF and the statewide film industry.

The FLC has engaged with WF staff to develop groundbreaking programs such as [Local Lens](#) and the [Media Mentorship Program](#). Once developed, proposals are taken to WF Board of Directors for further discussion, input, and adoption.

Terms and Time Commitment

Each FLC member serves a term of 2 years and may be nominated for up to 2 terms. The FLC has quarterly video meetings with the goal of meeting in-person once annually. Committees are formed and meet on an as needed basis.

If any FLC Member misses three (3) consecutive committee meetings without pre-notification to the Co-Chairs and / or WF staff it will be assumed that the member does not have the capacity to serve and as such has resigned.

The Co-Chairs may dismiss members that misrepresent or tarnish the reputation of WF and / or the FLC.

FLC Recruitment

In anticipation of recruiting new members, WF Staff circulates a survey to current FLC members to identify gaps in membership. Using this survey as the roadmap for recruitment, current FLC members are asked to nominate new members and each nominee will be cross referenced against a matrix of desired skill sets to ensure that the committee reflects the statewide film industry.

WF staff will conduct informational interviews with each finalist candidate. After informational interviews are complete, finalist candidates will be presented to WF Recruitment Committee made up 3-4 members of the Board. Final approval of new FLC members will take place at WF regularly scheduled quarterly board meetings.

The FLC will also nominate 3-5 candidates for the Co-Chair positions and they may nominate FLC committee members and individuals not currently serving on the committee. WF Recruitment Committee will review the candidates and interview top candidates. Final approval of the new FLC Co-Chairs will take place at WF regularly scheduled quarterly board meetings.
